Subject: Update - Manufacturer's Approved Drawings- Guardrail End Treatments in Concrete Pavement

This is notification to design, construction and maintenance personnel of an update to the ET-PLUS and the SKT 350 Manufacturer's approved drawings for guardrail end treatments when being placed in concrete. ET-PLUS drawing SS-359 is replaced by SS-409 and SKT 350 drawing SKT-W-8US-AZ LEAVEOUT is replaced by SKT-S-8US-AZ LEAVEOUT. You can access the new drawings at the following Roadway Design website:

The basic change that is being implemented is to replace a wood post in sleeve system with steel posts in sleeves that will help facilitate ease of maintenance. The following guidance is provided for implementation: **Design** - include the updated Layout for ET-PLUS (PCCP) and Layout for SKT 350 (PCCP) in your respective plans where applicable prior to advertising. **Construction** - the updated end treatments may be constructed if desired for ongoing projects. **Maintenance** - please note that the previous drawings are still appropriate for maintenance purposes.
